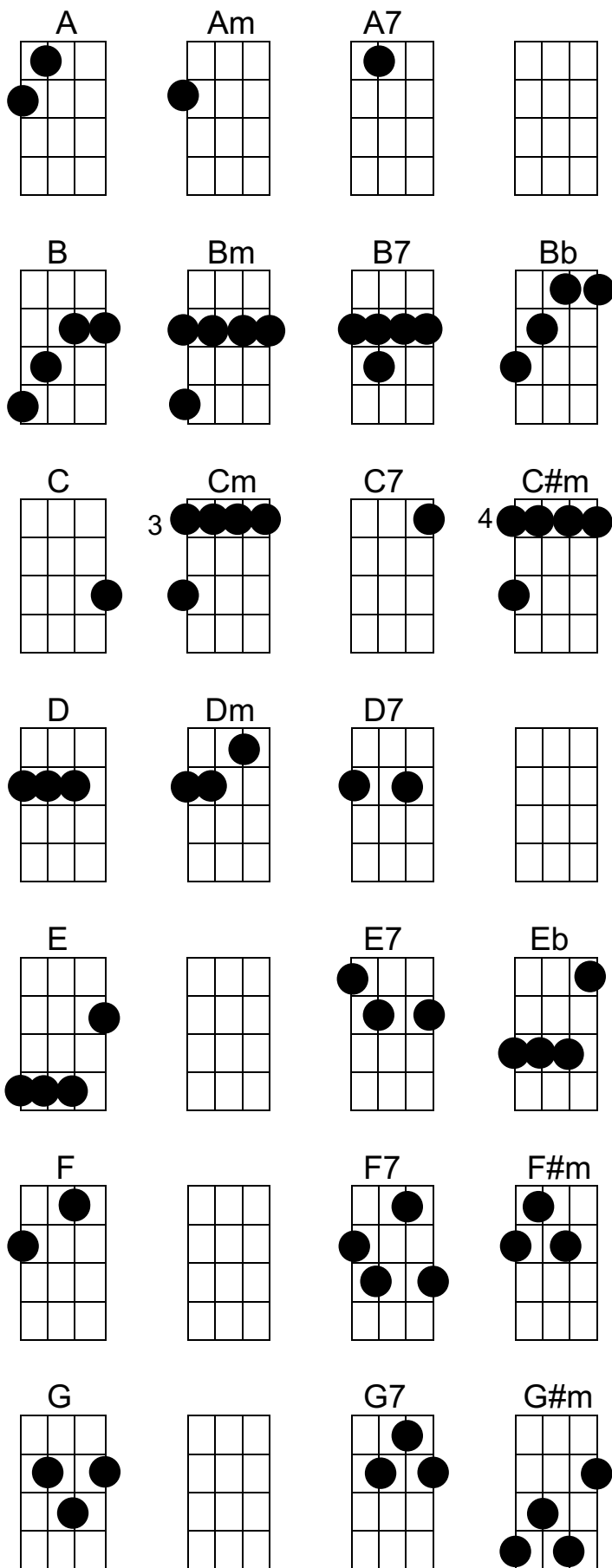

#### Backstory:

In 1908, paniolo (Hawaiian cowboys) Ikua Purdy, Archie Ka'aua and Jack Low traveled from Hawaii to Wyoming to compete in the World's Steer Roping Championship at the Cheyenne Frontier Days rodeo, the biggest rodeo at the time. Ikua Purdy placed first, Archie Ka'aua third, and Jack Low sixth.

In 1999, Ikua Purdy was voted into the National Cowboy Museum Rodeo Hall of Fame and was the first inductee to the O'ahu Cattlemen's Association Paniolo Hall of Fame. In 2007, Purdy was inducted into the Cheyenne Frontier Days Hall of Fame.
